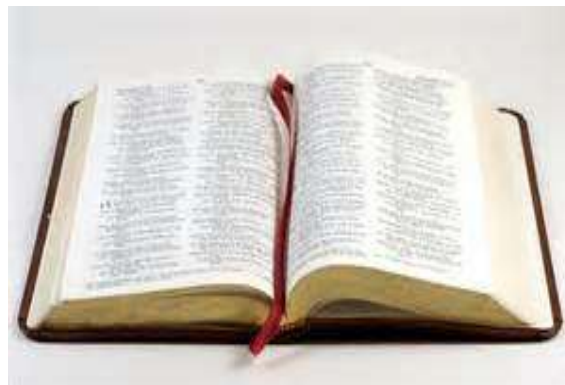

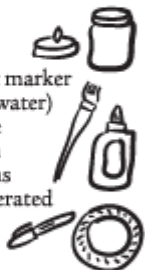

# A STARRY LIGHT

**What you do:**
